

Directions to Cellana's Kona Demonstration Facility at the Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawaii Authority

From the South (Kailua-Kona town)

- Head north on the Queen Kaahumanu Hwy 19 for approximately nine miles.
- Turn left into the Natural Energy Lab of Hawaii Authority Makako Bay Road which is approximately one mile before airport.
- See directions from Makako Bay Road below.

From the North (Kona International Airport)

- Head south on the Queen Kaahumanu Hwy 19 for approximately one mile.
- Turn right into the Natural Energy Lab of Hawaii Authority Makako Bay Road.
- See directions from Makako Bay Road below.

From Otec Road

- Proceed on Makako Bay Road for about 1.5 miles. You will pass Cyanotech on the right and see the Cellana sign to your right along with other signs for Kona Coast Shellfish, No Beach Access and Taylor Shellfish.
- Turn right on Unualoha Point Drive onto the unpaved road.
- Follow the road North for approximately a half mile along the coastline past the ponds on the right. The Cellana facility is on your right surrounded by a green fence. A Cellana sign is posted at the gate.
- Turn right into the main gate and proceed to the parking lot. All visitors must check in at the administration office (the middle building just left of the loading dock area).

Due to safety and confidentiality, please no children, no cameras and you must wear closed toed shoes.

As this is a working facility, appointments are required for tours.
